Children are at high risk when exposed



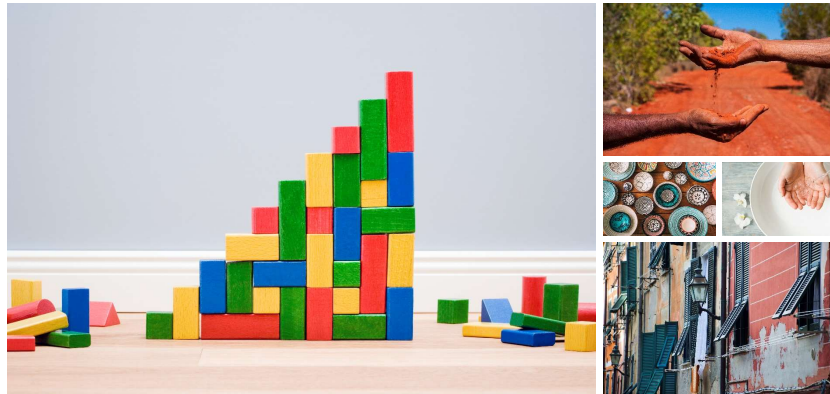

## What's the big deal about lead poisoning?

- Lead sickness does not always cause symptoms we can see
- Lead can **permanently** harm the brain and nervous system
- Lead can cause learning problems, attention problems, and behavior problems
- Lead can sometimes cause speech and hearing problems and slow down growth

## What can FCC providers do?

Remove any lead in the home

- Use wet paper towels to clean up dust with lead
- Clean around windows and play areas
- Wet mop floors
- Wash hands and toys with soap and water
- Use duct tape to cover chipping or peeling paint

## Key Points

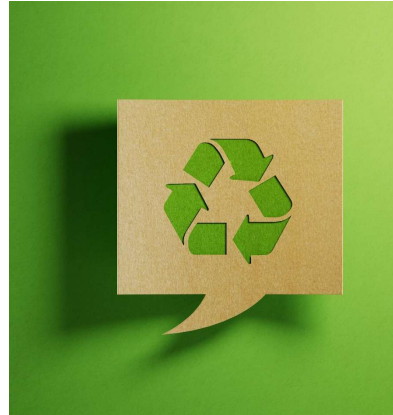
- Lead exposure can harm young children and babies even before they are born!

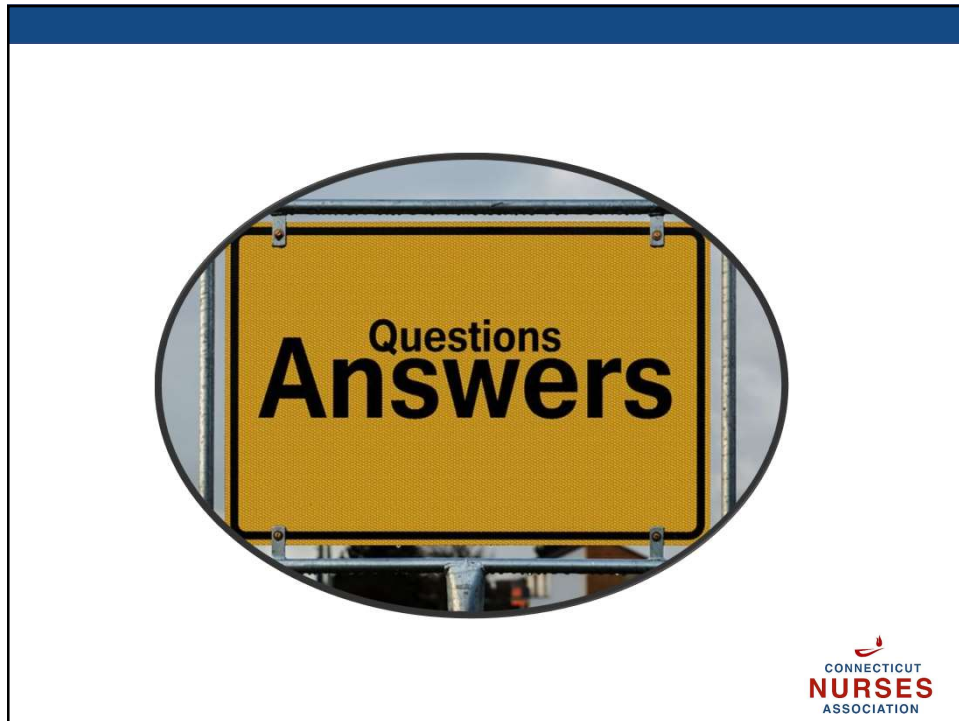

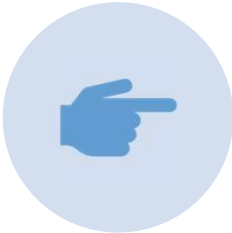

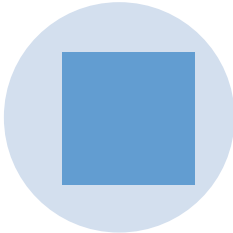
