First Aid Certification



OEC requires FCC providers to:

- Complete an approved First Aid course (6 hours in length)
- Every three years

What's in your first aid kit?



Maintain at least one (1) portable, readily available first aid kit:

- Wherever children are in care
- On field trips
- At outdoor play areas
- In the FCC home if all of the children do not attend the field trip

2. Sterile, individually wrapped, three (3) or four (4) inch gauze squares

3. A two (2) inch gauze roller bandage



4. One (1) roll of adhesive tape (hypoallergenic)

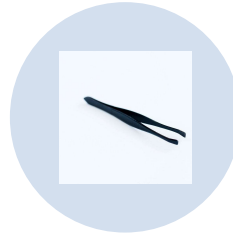

8. A non-glass thermometer to measure a child's temperature with plastic covers for the thermometer or alcohol to clean the thermometer, or single use Tempa Dots
